BEST SMARTPHONE OF 2012



Initially, a smartphone is a cellular phone having the features and characteristics of a regular cellular phone that enables the users to perform various actions which are not limited to; sending and receiving short and multimedia messages, listening to music, browsing the web

pages, taking pictures, shooting videos, viewing videos and video calling. Furthermore, a smartphone is a "pocket PC" as it contains a powerful computer processor and runs a complete operating system such as Android which is open source software. (Android phones-operating system, 2012)

Furthermore, the decision to buy a smartphone is dependent on the use of the smartphone. For instance, a travelling businessman would use the smartphone to check his emails regularly while a regular user may purchase the smartphone to listen to music or browse the web to check for updates and notification on social networking sites in order to stay in touch with friends and families. Furthermore, there are also people who are technology orientated and who would purchase and own a smartphone to keep themselves up to date with the technologies of this century.

The following are some of the things to look out for when buying a smartphone such as; the ability of the smartphone to access the internet or in other words, whether the phone supports WiFi as well as being compatible with the different types of connections such as GPRS, EDGE, HSDPA and 3G. One should also consider the storage capacity of the phone to enable one "to store pictures, music, videos, apps and games" (Buying a Smartphone- 7 things to remember, 2010) that one can carry around with them anywhere they go. Finally, multitasking is also a feature that one would look for in a smartphone. For instance, people look for smartphones with a Dual Core Processor as it "increases the computing power; enables faster video buffering and smooth HD playback while at the same time allows for faster web browsing". The features such as high image resolution, enhanced sound quality and sharp display are also important qualities that people look out for when purchasing a smartphone.

I believe that the best smartphone available in the market is Samsung Galaxy 3 and is available in white and pebble blue color. It has dimensions of 113.5 x 12.9 x 12.9mm and weighs 109 grams with TFT touch screen associated with 16M colors and a size of 240 x 400 pixels. In addition, it contains a Lithium-Ion standard battery enabling it to last 620 hours of standby time and 15 hours 30 minutes of talk time. Furthermore, the phone has a card slot which can contain a MicroSD of 32GB with internal storage capacity of 512MB ROM and 256 MB RAM and it is compatible with the different types of connections such as GPRS (32-48Kbps), EDGE (236.8Kbps), 3G (HSDPA 900/2100). It uses the Android OS version 2.2 and poses the Central processing unit- Samsung S5p6422667Mhz. (Samsung Galaxy 3- Full phone specifications, 2012)Finally, the phone has 4G capabilities, video chat, a 4 inch display and the Android operating system with a 2.2 version which enables it to perform the multimedia functions. For instant, the 4-inch touch screen display is suitable for video chats, video playback and for surfing the internet. The super Amoled brings images to life and the resolution makes watching movies, TV shows or playing games much more enjoyable. Hence, Samsung GALAXY 3 is more reliable than other smartphones available on the market. (Smartphones2012- smartphone reviews, 2012)


